



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












#### Aims:

Indigenist community-based participatory action research with Galiwin'ku


Indigenous & Western researchers & community members working together two-way

### 6 Yolnu Yalu researchers → extensive in-depth Yolnu knowledges old & new ways

- Senior Elders, Elders & future Elders
- representing both moieties & diverse clans

Western researchers → participating in & observing life in Galiwin'ku & outstation during 2 fieldwork visits this year & more next year

- April May 23 days → 3 researchers
- August Sept 15 days → 2 researchers




- in-depth yarning circles & conversations with Yolnu
   Yalu researchers throughout
- 32 conversations with Senior Elders, Elders & clan members across all but one of the 16 clans in clan languages and/or English
- mapping governance, kinship, education & songline systems
- collecting selected songlines
- now interpreting & analysing....



### What makes Yolnu stronger?




#### At the centre $\rightarrow$ Yolnu ROM & Constitution/Governance



- inner being spirit
- living on our country
  - kinship
  - language
  - culture
  - ceremonies
- healers physically, spiritually, emotionally
  - exchanging knowledges

### What makes Yolnu weaker?



- Balanda working on top of us
- not allowing us to live according to our Yolnu ROM
  - Balanda not recognizing
  - not working together two-way
    - don't know much about us
